## State-of-the-Art Facility

Recently improved to include the latest technology, Blue Grass Airport's new facility offers students a reliable, comfortable and challenging environment to learn and practice their skills.

- Classroom that accommodates groups of all sizes and includes audio/visual equipment
- Fuel Spill Trainer and Specialized Aircraft Fire Trainer—designed and built to replicate Boeing 737s
- Computer-controlled, propane-fueled equipment simulates large-scale flammable liquid fires, engine fires, wheel and brake fires and aircraft interior fires with rollover and flashover
- Modern Control Room with simulated computer programs to create multiple training scenarios
- Locker rooms with showers

## Course Descriptions

### **ARFF (100) Basic Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting**

This 40-hour course is designed to provide the necessary skills, knowledge and techniques to perform aircraft rescue fire fighting. This course meets or exceeds the requirements of FAR 139. Written and practical examinations will be administered.

### **ARFF (101) Basic ARFF Tactics and Strategy**

This 8-hour course is designed to prepare the company officer to properly and safely mitigate aircraft emergencies. Topics of instruction include rescue, fire suppression, ventilation, salvage and overhaul. Written and practical examinations will be administered.



### **ARFF (102) FAR 139 Certification Burn**

This 8-hour course is designed to meet or exceed FAA requirements as found in FAR 139.319(J)(3). The Fuel Spill Trainer or the Specialized Aircraft Fire Trainer may be utilized dependent upon airport index level and department requirements.

### **ARFF (103) Structural Approach to ARFF**

This 8-hour course is designed to prepare the structural firefighter to mitigate aircraft accidents and incidents. Topics of instruction include aircraft familiarization, rescue and fire suppression. Written and practical examinations will be administered.
