SEALED BIDS for the West Airfield Lighting Project and other incidental items will be received by the LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY AIRPORT BOARD (hereinafter referred to as "LFUCAB") in the Board Room until and not later than 1:00 P.M. Local Time on the 26th day of June, 2024, at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Board Room of the Blue Grass Airport.

THE PROJECT consists primarily of airfield lighting replacement, runway navigational aid removal, runway navigational aid installation, and airfield electrical vault modifications.

BIDDERS must be in good standing with the Commonwealth of Kentucky and be qualified to meet all Local, State and Federal statutes, codes, regulations, and ordinances governing the performance of the type of work for which Bidder is submitting a Bid. Additionally, Bidders must have a contractors' license issued by the LFUCG.
